## Costalegre, Mexico

The Costalegre is one of Mexico's last coasts. The rugged coastline runs south from Puerto Vallarta to the next major city, Manzanillo. In between is 150 miles of protected natural coast, thick with palm forests, lush jungle-covered mountains, and wild beaches that stretch endlessly for miles.

Just a few high-end hotels are scattered along the Costalegre, but all is set to change in the next few years as resorts like the Four Seasons and a new luxe project called Xala are slated to open. Improvements to the highway and a new airport will make the Costalegre much more accessible—and popular—very, very soon.
