DEPLAR FARM ICELAND

Encircled by the mountains of northern Iceland's Troll Peninsula, miles away from its nearest neighbour, Deplar Farm is renowned as one of the world's most exclusive hideaways. Originally part of an 18th-century sheep farm, the lodge has a turf-covered roof that helps it blend seamlessly into an otherworldly landscape – the perfect backdrop for adventures such as heli-skiing, kayaking and salmon-fishing. Inside, there is a superb gym and yoga studio, plus a chic bar filled with mid-century furniture and a healthy dose of *hygge*. At night, dine on delicious wild-caught char or pasture-raised lamb, then go for a tranquil float in the outdoor geothermal pool under the glow of the Northern Lights. VILLA COPENHAGEN DENMARK

One of this year's most anticipated openings, Villa Copenhagen has emerged as the epitome of conscious luxury. The city's former Central Post & Telegraph head office has undergone an elegant conversion, with interiors inspired by the 19th-century Danish painter Vilhelm Hammershoi (expect muted tones, gold accents and herringbone floors). Soothing bathroom products in refillable bottles come courtesy of the fragrance brand Skandinavisk, and the 50-square-metre Earth Suite has been designed using sustainable materials. In addition, guests can enjoy one of the city's few green spaces – a rooftop garden filled with herbs that contribute to the hotel restaurant's farm-to-fork ethos.
